### Key Dates

- **September 23, 2024:** OCIA classes begin.
- **November 4, 2024:** Late signup cutoff (unless approved by Father Kleinmann).
- **November 18, 2024:** Deadline for submitting completed *OCIA registration forms*. Based on the information you provide, Father Moschetto will begin working with you to address any possible impediments to receiving the Sacraments.
- **January 6, 2025:** Deadline for supporting documentation, including Baptismal Certificates and Marriage Certificates (if applicable). *Note: This documentation is necessary if you intend to receive, or are seriously considering receiving, the Sacraments at the Easter Vigil. Observers who do not plan to enter the church do not need to submit these items.*
- **March 3, 2025:** Deadline for *Sponsor Forms* for those who are planning to receive the sacraments or are seriously considering it. If your desired sponsor is not a Saint Veronica’s parishioner, a letter or form from their home parish certifying their suitability is also necessary. *Please inform Scott or Melissa if you need assistance finding a sponsor!*
- **March 9, 2025:** Diocesan *Rite of Election* to be held with Bishop Burbidge (location and time to be determined).
- **March 23** (9:00 a.m.), **March 30** (10:45 a.m.), and **April 6** (9:00 a.m.): *Scrutinies* at Saint Veronica during Sunday Masses.
- **March 31, 2025:** Deadline for providing your desired *Confirmation Saint Name* if you plan to be Confirmed at the Vigil.
- **Weeks of April 7 and April 14:** Father Kleinmann, Father Moschetto, Scott and Melissa, and parish office staff will verify that all necessary documentation is complete. If anything needs further attention, we will contact you directly.
- **April 19, 2025:** *Sacraments of Initiation* at the *Easter Vigil Mass*. Welcome home!
- **May 19, 2025:** Last OCIA class.
